1. Purpose. To establish and promulgate a standard command-wide matrix that formalizes the four phases and ten steps for Encroachment Partnering.

2. Background

a. Reference (a) permits the Military Services to enter into encroachment partnering agreements with eligible entities to acquire interests in real property if certain conditions are met. The Marine Corps has a successful track record in protecting mission requirements through encroachment partnering projects, particularly in competing for funds available through the OSD Readiness and Environmental Protection Integration Program. Reference (b) directed the MCICOM G-7 to standardize relationships throughout Headquarters Marine Corps, the MCI Regions and Installations with regard to G-7 Government and External Affairs, and Community Plans and Liaison Officers (CPLO).

b. The Encroachment Partnering construct involves various levels of commands and staffs across the Department of Defense. Encroachment Partnering management requires close coordination and communication; a standard command-wide construct provides for unity of effort.

3. Policy

a. MCICOM subordinate commands and Service Level Training Installations shall manage and implement the Encroachment Partnering Matrix as detailed in the enclosure.

b. MCICOM subordinate commands and Service Level Training Installations shall follow the process set forth in the enclosure when developing, executing, and monitoring encroachment partnering projects.


c. The MCICOM G-7 has primary oversight and program management responsibility. The development of Encroachment Partnering projects

shall occur through their command Encroachment Management Action Team or its functional equivalent.

4. The enclosure is to be implemented upon receipt and shall be integrated into the next update to reference (c).

5. This Encroachment Partnership Process applies to continental United States installations and MCB Hawaii only.
